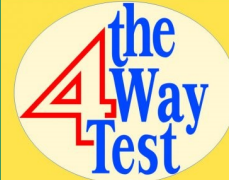

Tiny House Project Eric Cannada

A “tiny house” is exactly what the name says - a small house that has the features and requirements of a larger home, just on a much smaller scale.

The houses are built from an architectural drawing and are 128 square feet. The Tiny House Project at Dublin High School was created to teach students construction and the skilled trades associated with the construction industry. Classes teach students these trades by actually building a tiny house.



The Tiny House Project has teamed up with a non profit organization, The Widows Oil Ministry, to take ownership of the homes and use them to help the working poor and homeless. The plan is to locate the houses inside the city limits of Dublin. The non profit will set the requirements to determine those chosen to live in the houses.

Students learn a skill while building and helping the community. They are gaining a sense of pride in their hard work and will be able to see a finished completed home that will be lived in for years to come. Eric Cannada is the CEO of the Heart of Georgia College and Career Academy. He and his wife Tracie moved to Dublin in 1989 with Fairview Park Hospital and quickly transitioned to a career as a teacher and coach with Dublin City Schools. Thirty years and three kids later they are still here. “We decided Dublin is a good place to raise a family and now our children know no other home.” While at Dublin City Schools, Eric worked in Technology and Transportation as well as the Career Technical and Agriculture programs. Their oldest child, Briceton, graduated from Dublin High and the Air Force Academy. Jon-Luke graduated from Trinity Christian School and Georgia Southwestern. Their youngest child and only girl, Kate Cannada, is a senior at Trinity Christian School this year.
