DAVID KINCAID Executive Director



Pastor David Kincaid serves as Executive Director for Teen Challenge Middle Georgia. David began his ministry in Christian Camping, followed by over four years in Rescue Missions serving as Assistant Director of the Union Gospel Mission in Bakersfield, California and helping to pioneer City Missions in Riverside and San Bernardino.

Davis had a long history working with youth and at risk individuals before coming to Teen Challenge in 2003. In spite of his accomplishments, David struggled with his own addictions for over 20 years. At the age of 35, David entered the Teen Challenge program in Fort Myers, Florida. Throughout the program, David surrendered not only his life but his future to Christ. After completing the one year program and an additional year of internship, David transitioned into a full time ministry position with Teen Challenge. While in Fort Myers David served in a variety of roles including Work Project Coordinator, Administrative Assistant, Campus Pastor and Program Manager. In 2005 David received his certification as a Behavioral Health Technician.

David met Trista, a children's pastor and missionary, and married in 2006. David spent 18 months interning for a local church while working to obtain his Pastoral Credentials and was ordained in 2007.

In 2010, David was asked to serve as Executive Director for Teen Challenge Middle Georgia where he oversees the 60 bed Men's campus in Dublin and the 8 bed Transitional Home in Macon and the newly opened Teen Challenge Super Thrift Store in East Dublin.

David and Trista have two children, Daniel (7) and Gianna (4). David has served locally on the United Ways allocations committee, teaches evangelism in their home church, Dexter Assesmbly. He is also a 2015 graduate of Leadership Dublin-Laurens County.
