Vineyard and Winery Association of West Georgia Founder and Executive Director Doug Mabry has been instrumental in getting the association on its feet and conducting historical research regarding vineyards and wineries in west Georgia and east Alabama. A capable organizer, Mabry gathered around him those interested in seeking a viable sustainable agriculture initiative for Carroll County and the surrounding area by way of the production of wine grapes and their eventual conversion into wine, a wonderful example of value added business practices.

The Association is organized to provide for education in viticulture and enology, the promotion of fruit for the production of value added products with wine as the main focus, and the improvement and development of sustainable agriculture.

Mr. Mabry received a B.S. Education at Mercer University in 1997 and then went on to study Anthropology at University of West Georgia. A historian and anthropologist, he has identified and was able to have preserved over 1000 acres of historic and environmentally important land for new parks. He has done research and developed three history museums and received the 2008 State Preservation Achievement Award from Georgia Department of Natural Resources. Recently, Doug organized the 2015 Georgia Trustees Wine Challenge which was the first statewide wine competition.

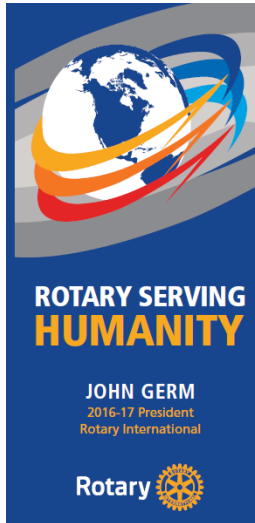
